A WLCG workshop will be held at NYU during the weekend before CHEP 2012. In addition, the CHEP organizers have agreed to host the DPHEP meeting at the same venue.

Registration

Although the early registration deadline has passed, online registration for CHEP and WLCG will be available until May 18. Because of liability issues at the conference venues, <u>on-site registration will not be possible</u>. All conference participants must pre-register online before coming to CHEP.

Registration covers the conference fee, welcome reception and banquet (CHEP only), respective coffee breaks (WLCG and/or CHEP), and publication of the conference proceedings (CHEP only). Discounts are available to students and BNL participants. All figures shown are in US dollars.

Please note that participation in the DPHEP meeting is only available to CHEP conference participants.

Cancellation Policy

Confirmed conference participants may only cancel registration with a written request to chep2012@bnl.gov. A 15% cancellation fee will be charged if the cancellation request is received before April 2. No refund requests after April 2 will be honored.

Registered participants who cannot attend CHEP due to visa issues can obtain a full refund of the registration fee if a request is made before May 1. No refund requests after May 1 (for visa issues only) will be honored.

Letters of Invitation

If a registered participant requires a letter of invitation in connection with a US visa application, please contact us at chep2012@bnl.gov and provide a physical address. We will mail an official letter of invitation promptly.

Lodging

Hotel rooms and NYU dorm rooms remain available until respective deadlines (see www.chep2012.org/lodging.php for details). The LOC will be releasing room blocks at the respective deadlines to avoid any further liability on the part of the organizers. NYU dorm room reservations will not be accepted after March 15 due to contractual obligations.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

Due to the large number of posters accepted for CHEP, the organizers have broken up poster presentation into two sessions. Posters accepted under tracks 3 and 4 will be presented on Tuesday, May 22, while posters accepted in tracks 1, 2, 5 and 6 will be presented on Thursday, May 24. Poster set-up days are Monday and Wednesday, and poster take-down deadline is 5 pm

on Tuesday and Thursday, respectively. For a single, one-page poster, the maximum size is 4 ft. tall by 2 ft. wide (122 cm x 61 cm). If posters are printed on standard letter (US) or A4 (Europe) sizes, then posters can be composed of 4 sheets tall x 3 sheets wide (portrait orientation) or 5 sheets tall x 2 sheets wide (landscape orientation).

Conference Proceedings

The organizers have arranged to publish the proceedings electronically in the Journal of Physics through IOP Publishing, about 2 months after the conference. All <u>presented</u> contributions (both oral and poster presentations) in the conference proceedings will be published. <u>Papers from all presented contributions must be submitted online by May 25, 2012</u>.
